

PTA Report for the year 2022- 23

In the year 2022-23 three PTA executive committee meeting and two general body meeting were conducted. The general body meeting were conducted on 23-11-2022 and 17-03-2023. As per the decisions taken in the PTA executive committee meeting the following actions / programs were taken during the academic year.

1. An amount of rupees 1, 10,000(one lakh ten thousand) was given to 101 students as scholarship for their excellent performances in academic and non-academic subjects.
2. Dr Jeena and Dr. Jesna of Economics department were honoured for achieving PhD.
3. Dr. Biju, principal was honoured for acquiring first professor -ship among MES colleges.
4. The mess bill and the hostel bill of one student each from M Com Finance and MSc Botany were met from the PTA fund.
5. An amount of rupees 60 lakh was given from PTA fund for the extension work of the college library. (11/5/2022- 25, 00,000, 10/6/2022- 20, 00,000 and 2/2/2023- 15, 00,000).
6. Financial assistance was given to students for participating in the sports activities viz. football, boxing, University athletic meet, national championship etc.
7. An amount of rupees 3, 00,000 (three lakh) was granted for fine arts programs. So also for music choir training.
8. As has been done in the previous years, sufficient financial assistance was given for the functioning of NSS programs.
9. The remuneration for the guest faculties working in the Botany department is being paid from the PTA fund.
10. The medical expenses of the deceased student Fadil was met from PTA fund.
11. For the benefits of the students, various programs like NET coaching, pathway social life wellness program, anti-drug program, vimukti etc. were conducted with the financial assistance of the PTA.
12. Financial assistance was given to both teachers and students for FDP, participating in various programs like international conferences, international paper presentation etc.
13. Financial assistance was also given for conducting National seminar, psychological counselling classes etc.

14. A student from B. Com co-operation is being given financial assistance from PTA since January 2023.

15. All the expenses relating to college website, purchase of newspapers, subscription of hostel Wi-Fi etc. are being met from PTA fund.

16. In case of emergency, travelling expenses of students to hospital are being met by the PTA.

17. Incorporation with the financial collection done by the self-finance (management stream) students an Air conditioner was purchased and gifted to BUDS centre Mathilakam.

18. An external audit of PTA fund account for the period from 1-4-2019 to 31-3-2022 was conducted.
