# **REPORT OF ANTI RAGGING CELL**


## **2024-2025**




**DAY - IV – SESSION- I – ANTI RAGGING SELFIE CORNER**

- Responsibilities were assigned and it was decided to conduct periodic reviews to assess the effectiveness of the preventive measures.

The meeting concluded with a commitment to promote a safe and inclusive campus environment, prevent ragging and ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.
